



## MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

HELD ON 3RD AUGUST 2023 AT THE EVANGEL ASSEMBLIES OF GOD CHURCH, ADABRAKA, ACCRA

### 1.0 OPENING & DEVOTION

#### 1.1 Opening

The Meeting started at 1:00 pm prompt, Rev. Mrs. Olga Amartefio (Member of the National Prayer Committee) led and summed up the prayers to commence deliberations. The 2023 AGM was historic, in the sense of having two modes of participation; in-person and virtual.

#### 1.2 Devotion

Mrs. Florence Hutchful led the devotion and gave an exhortation on the theme, “**God's Word – Unchanging**”, which was based on a Scriptural text from **Malachi 3**. She indicated that the Word of God remains true and “it has the power to guide our lives”, so we must continue to trust and obey God's Word, and never relent on upholding our Christian values and character. It was her admonition that though we find ourselves in times of economic hardship, the hard times need not be allowed to influence and determine our character. She urged members to live a life of honesty, purity and total dedication to God by doing what is right. She charged members to always remember that God's unchanging word remains the hope for all.

The team for Bible translation project for the Effutu-Senya commenced work in January 2022 whilst the Okere team came on board in July 2022. The first stakeholder engagement for the Wassa Project was done in September 2022.

## 6.10 Translation Seminars

The Translation Department organized Translation Seminars at four locations on relevant topics. Three locations - Accra, Kumasi and Nkwanta had the seminar under the theme *“Bible Translation as a Ministry”*. However, to meet the specific needs of the Church within the Takoradi area, the Seminar was organized with the theme *“Significance of Scripture Versions and Bible Helps”*. This was to meet the specific needs of the Church within the area.

## 6.11 Diglots: Ewe-ESV, Akuapem-Twi-ESV, and Mfantse-ESV

The Meeting was informed that the Ewe-ESV Diglot would be published in 2023. Akuapem-Twi and Mfantse-ESV Diglots were ongoing and estimated to be published in 2024.

## 6.12 Bible Distribution

A total of 593,498 Bibles were distributed in 2022 throughout Ghana as against a target of 723,508. The Bibles reached individuals and communities across various regions, including urban centers, rural areas, schools, prisons, hospitals, and churches. The total number of Bibles distributed amounted to **GHC 19,737,643.81**.

## 6.13 Programmes & Church Relations

The annual Bible Week was celebrated in 433 churches in 2022 compared to the 401 churches in 2021. The celebration took place from the 5th -13th February 2022 under the theme: *“The Bible and Integrity”*. Several Ministers of the Gospel across the country were assigned to speak on the theme at various churches. The weeklong activities observed by Churches, Local Council of Churches, and other stakeholders in Ghana included:

## 6.14 Communication & Resource Mobilization

The Society received a total of **GHC 3,002,567.60** as donations from Churches and Individuals in the period under review as against a budget of **GHC 3,185,000.00**. The donations constituted a 94.27% of the target.

## 6.15 Corporate Social Responsibility

The BSG distributed a total of **66,858** Bibles worth **GHC182,400.00** and **\$475,826** to security services and schools. A leadership training seminar was organized for about 1,000 young professionals in Tamale, Takoradi, Ho, Western North and Accra respectively. The sessions were delivered under the following topics: Integrity, Accountability and Transparency, Integrity and Time Management, and Integrity and Servant Leadership.
